What do we do?

We recently promoted a health survey that generated 311 responses worldwide, we are using the data gathered to decide our next area of interest. It could be just simple husbandry advice; it could be more detailed analysis or working with a veterinary or a research institute (such as AHT) on an issue that appears to be increasing in frequency or importance.

Currently as a result of owners performing Embark testing, Progressive Retinal Atrophy (PRA) has been raised as an issue. We are working with AHT to determine how much of an issue it is. Please see the details on our Facebook Page if you wish to help

How do we raise funds?

Our principal fundraiser has been Clumberfest. We initially raised money to support the Clumber Spaniel Club (CSC) Health Committee and in fact there is £500 set aside in CSC Funds for

supporting the “Give a Dog a Genome” project (by AHT), However, in 2019 we had no commitment to give funds to CSC, so decided to set up CSH to be more agile and better inform Clumber owners. The PRA project with AHT is quite expensive and will use all our funds raised from Clumberfest and we will need to raise more, so we have set up a Just Giving page to raise £1500. Any amount will be gratefully received. Any money in excess of what we need will go forward to our next project.

Recent Events

Lynn and Adrian Peters recently met with AHT and Embark at Crufts and had a very interesting discussion. Having spoken to both AHT and Embark we are confident that the projects we are running and planning do not conflict with any projects run by any other clubs/societies in the UK.

We are also speaking to Embark to get an IOHC project of the ground and that may well include the American Clumber Spaniel Foundation as IOHC is also an issue “across the pond”.

All we want is to have is the best for our Clumber Spaniels. Last years there were less than 200 puppies born in the UK, that in itself is worrying. Of more concern is the increase in incidence of IOHC and PRA in our breed, which we need to understand how and why and do our best to find out why it happens and knowing that with good breeding practice maybe we can reduce the occurrence.

GIVE A DOG A GENOME

Finally, we are always looking to the next project. The AHT have been running a Give a Dog A Genome Project for a number of years now, the Clumber Spaniels missed out on the first tranche, but at the meeting with AHT at Crufts Clumber Spaniel Health were told that if we can find the £2000, Clumber Spaniels can be included!

This is really great news, so watch out for more details in the future.
